



RoHS Compliance Declaration Form

The directive 2011/65/EU on the Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment (EEE) known as RoHS (2), entered into force on the 21st July 2011. Member states of the European Union were to transpose this into national law by the 2nd January 2013. This has since been updated by directive 2015/863 to include 4 Phthalates (RoHS 3).

We hereby confirm that all parts supplied by Ley Rubber Ltd contain less than the following concentrations by weight of restricted substances as details in Directive 2011/65/EU and Directive 2015/863 (RoHS 3).

- **Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) (0.1%)**
- **Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP) (0.1%)**

The REACH European regulation (EC) 1907/2006 entered into force on the 1st June 2007 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and restriction of Chemicals.

We hereby confirm that all parts supplied by Ley Rubber Ltd, do not contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as details in the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) candidate list (last updated July 2021) to 219 SVHCs.
